From the Institute for Political Studies in Bordeaux to French and British universities, economic, social and political sciences, law and finance, history and geography.

In the world of work she discovers the wealth of complementarity between academic learning and training by action. Now, she continues to support links between individuals and projects by a combination of actions, thinking and training. Her curiosity has led her to explore the eclectic nature of interactions between people and companies: mediation, theatre-forum, non-violent communication, the art of accompanying change, symbolic modelling, brand coaching...

Fifteen years of experience in Managing People and Projects

Her experience as a manager has led Corine Navarro to get to know private and public sectors, employees and entrepreneurs, associations and mutual funds. She can draw on a range of social techniques to boost the economic situation of an organisation. She is able to implement the entire range of Managing People and Projects functions:

- reorganisation, coordination, running and stabilising management in contexts of change or creation of structures (teams from 15 to 60 employees);
- negotiation and relations with customers, socio-economic and institutional partners, councillors, the media, sub-contractors, staff representatives;
- budget management (up to 4 million Euros);
- managing projects: regulation reforms, European programme, quality process...

After seven years working for the French Job Centre, in pursuit of a childhood dream she prepared the entrance examination for the National School of Administration, a new learning opportunity. She then worked for a group of retirement residences with medical facilities. After having tested and developed her activity in a cooperative, she created AdVolution atp in 2006. She is planning to acquire shares in a cooperative in 2012.

Pedagogy at the heart of intercultural cooperation

In 1990-91, during the Gulf War, Corine Navarro lived in a hall of residence of the University of Exeter (United Kingdom) housing students from all over the world, from different companies involved in the conflict: an enriching exercise in learning about the common values of the different cultures in the world.

In parallel with her professional involvement, she joined the Junior Chamber International, the "first movement for training young people to take responsibility for positive change". She was able to add transmission to action and steering. In this context of intercultural humanism, she learned about pedagogic engineering and design, development and teaching.

Intercultural management

To make links between professionals from different countries in the world easier, she is developing a part of her activities internationally, in an intercultural framework.
